Mountain Craft Wide Plank is a manufacture of custom hardwood products including flooring, solid wood paneling, mouldings, wood beams, stair parts and other accessories. We are a simple company, offering only the best products we can control.

Our location in the Appalachian Mountains places us in the center of arguably the most beautiful timber in the world. The local timber has been shipped to every corner of the globe, and never fails to please. Working directly with local loggers, Mountain Craft Wide Plank has the opportunity to receive and process some of the most sought out timber available.

Once the logs have been selected they are center sawn to reveal the beauty of the lumber while maximizing plank widths. After sawing, all lumber is then dried to a 7% moisture content in our on-site kiln. From there the lumber moves to our factory to be double side planed, ripped to width, optimized, moulded, defected, end-matched then customized to clients desire.

Being that our loggers work directly with professional foresters, clients are ensured that the timber extracted have only benefited the forest as a whole. From here the timber is given a second life in the form of quality hardwood flooring, paneling, and trim to last several lifetimes.

GRADE

Mountain Craft offers three different types of character for each species – young, old, and a blend of young and old.

Younger Wood

The grade of younger wood consist of less character and is usually more uniform in color within planks. The younger wood is typically taken from the outermost lumber in the log. Knots displayed in the younger wood grade are smaller than nickel in size, and only appearing occasionally.



Older Wood

The wood located in the center of a log displays the characteristics throughout the tree's life. Limbs that break and are overcome by new wood are now displayed as knots thourought the lumber. The older grade flooring has little restrictions on knot size or color uniformity between planks.

Mountain Craft Wide Plank flooring is machined as a micro bevel match for pre finish applications or a straight edge match for on-site finishing. All flooring comes with a standard tongue and groove end (end-match). Planks are available in lengths of 16' and nothing shorter than 12". Custom lengths are also available for herringbone and other custom install patterns. Available flooring plank widths are 2" up to 8", as single size planks or varying width packages i.e. (3",4",5"), (5",6",7"), (3",5",7") (6",8").

Straight Edge

The pre finished option is a satin lacquer based 4mm thick flooring grade finish. Planks are spray coated which finishes the top, sides and ends. Planks over 6" wide are also pre finished on the underside (option available on all widths). Custom color staining and matching are also available options.

CUSTOM OPTIONS AVAILABLE

Wire Brushing

Wire brushing removes some of the softer spring wood which provides depth and texture to the grain. Resulting in a highlighted grain throughout the wood. Wire Brushing is only available in the younger grade of Red and White Oak. Varying degrees of texture are available.



Hand Scraped

All species can be hand scraped, offering an authentic hand hewed appearance throughout the flooring. Each plank is authentically hand scraped by skilled craftsmen. Mountain Craft can vary the texture and intensity from a light scrape to a deeper, more pronounced, scrap of faces and edges.



Pinned Ends

Walnut pins can be applied to the ends of the plank for a truly distinctive look of early centuries. Available in 4" and greater width plank sizes.



Floor Featuring Antique Oak

Building a home and removing trees in the process? Consider using Mountain Craft to process the timber. Using your own timber in the build of your home, creating a story of a lifetime.



Conditioned White Oak

Mountain Craft wide plank also offers White Oak that has been treated with a chemical base and acid. The chemical base and acid reacts with the tannic acid in the White Oak. Creating a stunning effect that brings out the true depth and beauty of our Appalachian hardwood.



Antique White and Red Oak

The antique line created by Mountain Craft will satisfy any clients' desire for a rustic look in their wood flooring. Our craftsmen apply wear and stress marks throughout the entire surface of each plank. Customizations such as names, dates(s) or phrases can be added to the antique option.

Match any existing stain or truly create your own custom color with options from Mountain Craft Wide Plank.




Mountain Craft also manufactures casing, base, crown and other moulding profiles. Mouldings are offered pre finished or unfinished, up to 9" in width with any species available. Existing profiles can be recreated with a stain to match.



Casing Baseboard
